PREGNANCY SERVICES AND RESOURCES AVAILABLE FREE OF CHARGE

Pregnancy Testing -

Pathways offers free of charge lab quality urine pregnancy testing that is 99.8% accurate. In most situations, this is the first appointment for many of our clients.

Ultrasound -

Pathways offers free of charge first trimester limited ultrasounds to confirm that a pregnancy is located within the uterus, confirm a heart-beat and determine gestational age.

Options Education -

At Pathways, trained client advocates help you consider the impact that different pregnancy decisions may have on your life. Although we do not perform, nor refer for abortions, we can provide evidence-based education about your choices.

Earn While You Learn -

This educational program offers 215 lessons in a variety of different life-skills, pregnancy, and parenting topics. Through this program clients earn "Baby Bucks" to acquire items from our Boutique.

Pathways Boutique -

Pathways Pregnancy Clinic offers a fully stocked Boutique including diapers, formula, baby food, baby clothing, maternity clothing & more. These items are available to our clients free of charge.

Childbirth Education -

Pathways is proud to offer childbirth education classes, right here in Washougal! These classes are offered as a resource for our community and are open to pregnant women and their partners.

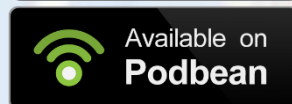

NW Furniture Bank helps restore hope, dignity and stability in our community by recycling donated furniture to people in need. Willing furniture store partners and local donations provide a steady source of furniture which would otherwise end up in the dump or sold at a loss. We serve victims of domestic abuse, people suffering loss from fire and natural disasters, foster children and especially families coming from transitional housing who are trying to rebuild their lives.



FURNITURE BANK PROGRAM

Our furniture assistance program is accessed exclusively on a referral basis. Families and individuals connect with an approved "caseworker" to complete a Furniture Request Form, providing us with critical information such as their household size, number of children in the household and their furniture needs. Families are then scheduled a shopping appointment to pick out their requested items from our inventory.
